

## **The instruction on the formation of the abstract**

The abstract is a brief description of the work outlined in the scientific article.

The abstract should be:

- Informative (do not contain common words, to reflect the main content of the article and the results of the research);
- Structured (follow the logic of describing the results in the article);
- Compact (fit into the volume of 150 to 180 words).

The abstract should contain:

- The main goal (s) of the study are described;
- Explains how the study was conducted, including the models used (without methodological details);
- Summed up the most important results and their significance.

The abstract should not contain:

- Abbreviations, if possible;
- Links to References.
